C R E A T I V E . Serving 31 years as a member of the Texas State Judiciary, and 12 years as an ADR facilitator, Judge Price has successfully kept his problem solving skills fresh and innovative.

As a district judge, Judge Price created several pioneering programs designed for efficient court management:

- * Direct filing of criminal cases into district courts – resulting in Houston serving as a model for other courts
- * Innovative and efficient system for juror selection in capital cases – as recognized by the Court of Criminal Appeals
- * Prospective juror questionnaire – now a model for most district courts
- * Court voir dire in capital cases – determined to be 10 years ahead of its time for anticipating appellate attacks

Judge Price’s continuing service to the bench as a visiting judge, as well as an arbitrator and mediator, have enabled Judge Price to resolve a myriad of complex civil cases, including: contracts, insurance, oil and gas, wrongful death, employment, real estate, fraud, construction, property damage, product liability, and medical and other professional liability claims; and, family law matters.

Judge Price received his Bachelor of Arts degree in History at Rice University in 1961, and his L.L. B. from Baylor University in 1963.
