E X P E R I E N C E . Judge Marshall's trial court statistics speak for themselves: over 23,000 civil case dispositions and 500+ jury trials.

Counsel know Judge Marshall as a skilled judge willing and able to take on diverse, complex, and controversial matters – such as the *Parkland AIDS* case (dispensation of experimental drugs to AIDS patients), and the *Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant* case (\$8 billion dollars in damages at stake).

Judge Marshall is co-author of Cooper, Hensley & Marshall's *Texas Rules of Civil Procedure* and an avid proponent and lecturer for CLE programs in law firms and professional organizations domestic and abroad. In 2004, Judge Marshall became the only American to receive the title of Honorary Professor of the Marie Curie-Sklodowska University in Poland.

Judge Marshall earned his law degree from SMU in 1975. In addition to a master's degree from Vanderbilt University, and a bachelor's degree from Virginia Military Institute, Judge Marshall received an honorary LL.D. from La Academia Mexicana de Derecho Internacional in 1985.
